

HEPA FILTERS FOR AT-RISK HOUSEHOLDS



This wildfire season, Climate Smart Glacier Country and Logan Health Foundation are partnering to provide free HEPA filters to eligible at-risk households in Flathead County.

HEPA Portable Air Filters are appliances that filter out tiny particulate matter in wildfire smoke. These appliances can plug into a standard wall outlet and circulate clean air in the room. Using a HEPA Air Filter can benefit those with respiratory issues.

WHO IS CONSIDERED AT-RISK?

Individuals with the following health conditions are considered at-risk for health problems during periods of poor air quality due to wildfire smoke.

- Lung or heart disease
- Asthma
- Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease
- Older age
- Other respiratory conditions

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR A FREE HEPA FILTER?

To be eligible you, or someone in the household, should have an at-risk health condition and qualify for Medicaid, SNAP, Section 8 or other public assistance.
